A VISION FOR STRAWBERRY HILL VILLAGE

BACKGROUND


From Richmond's Local Plan: "The vision for Strawberry Hill...the station will be improved & the impact of through traffic will be reduced where possible. Parking will be managed to allow residents to access local facilities & enjoy nearby open areas. Cycling will be encouraged".

At a recent Question Time event in Strawberry Hill, residents of the local area had the chance to quiz a panel of councillors on a number of these topics, raising questions over the future of St. Mary's University, parking limitations in the local area, & what can be done to improve the centre of Strawberry Hill Village.

Architecture:WK is a local business - with a team including three local residents - looking to help promote the enhancement of Strawberry Hill Village. We hope that this presentation may act as a sounding board, or prospective detailed visioning work, in order to help generate comment & further thinking regarding the area. We would like to stress that this is not a finalised solution for our village, but rather a catalyst for discussion & action - a statement which aims to encourage a unified vision for the local area.

OPPORTUNITIES & CONSTRAINTS

- 1. Give Pedestrian Priority make landscape enhancements to the area so that it works better both for the businesses & visiting locals.
- 2. Wellesley Parade get the Parade working better as a civic space, both for footfall to the shops, the enjoyment of residents &, in so far as practical, to optimise the station for drop off/waiting to best keep traffic moving during level crossing closings.
- 3. Station West Side Improve the platform, cycle storage area & the pedestrian footpaths around the back of Wellesley Court & towards Southfield Gardens. The objective is to ensure that the areas are better used & feel safer whilst protecting the privacy of Wellesley Court residents.
- 4. Station East Side Improve the platform, bring back into beneficial use the old station building, & improve Strawberry Hill Station cul-de-sac to allow for new station parking & for drop off/waiting zones.
- **5.** The Bridge re-make the pedestrian crossing over the railway so that more space is created for pedestrians & cyclists waiting for the crossing to open, so the discharge from the bridge is less close to the vehicle carriageway, & to help Wellesley Parade work better as a civic space.
