The Front Room is **Architecture WK**'s exciting vision for the Teddington High Street HSBC site, the latest in our series of **Social Initiative Projects**, in which our design team offers solutions for local sites that require improvement or redevelopment. The projects have no single client and no agenda other than improving our locality. If a proposal can be implemented, it would be a wonderful bonus.

The High Street branch of **HSBC closed in 2017**; a planning application for flats above a commercial unit was refused in June 2020. Believing the site should be developed to **enrich the cultural and social lives** of the local community, and mindful of planning policy aiming to retain local commercial and employment opportunities, we propose a luxury cinema for Teddington in the spirit of Esher's Everyman and Notting Hill's Electric Cinemas.
